

Notes for guidance on the parking of motorhomes in Flintshire County Council car parks

Unfortunately there are currently no formal facilities for motorhomes within Flintshire; however they are accommodated on the car parks, where possible, with the following provisions.

- Some car parks have height barriers at the entrance/exit; these are listed on the summary sheet however it is the driver's responsibility to check that their vehicle will pass through safely.
- All vehicles must park within a white-lined bay otherwise an excess charge will be issued. It is accepted that most motorhomes are too long to fit within a bay, in these circumstances the vehicle may extend into the next bay lengthways. There is no requirement to pay more than the standard tariff. Any encroachment into another bay or other area widthways will result in an excess charge.
- Do not park on access roads or turning areas.
- Drivers are requested to park with consideration to other car park users.
- Unfortunately there are no overnight facilities on any FCC car park.
- An estimate has been made as to the accessibility of each car park for motorhomes and this is shown on the summary sheet; this takes into account the manoeuvring space available. It should be noted that this is not a definitive ruling but an estimate based on an average coachbuilt unit of approximately 21' x 7'2". Smaller units may be able to utilise other car parks.
