

PARKING OF MOTOR HOMES IN STOKE ON TRENT

Introduction

The City of Stoke on Trent employs a weight restriction on all car parks throughout the City of 35cwt.

In addition, within Section 1 (point 15) of part 6 of the off street car parks consolidation order of 2002 it states:

‘No person shall use any part of a parking place or any vehicle left in a parking place for:

- a) sleeping or camping purposes, or
- b) eating or cooking purposes

- If a vehicle parks within bay confines and the dimensions of the vehicle means it overhangs into another bay, a ticket must be purchased for that additional bay.
- There are toilet facilities adjacent to the following car parks. However the facilities opening hours are presently 0845 to 1800 (Monday to Saturday):

Butterfield Place, Tunstall
 South Wolfe Street, Stoke
 City Road, Fenton

- There are no waste disposal facilities on the car parks
- There is no provision for dedicated spaces aimed at motor homes/caravans
- Access to all car parks is generally good
