

THE WEST OXFORDSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES)
(NO. 1) ORDER 2005

West Oxfordshire District Council (“the Council”) in exercise of the powers contained in Section 32 and 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (“the 1984 Act”) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act and having received the consent of Oxfordshire County Council in accordance with Section 39(3) of the Act hereby makes the following order:-

PART I

PREAMBLE AND INTERPRETATION

1. *This Order shall come into operation on the 16th May two thousand and five and may be cited as the West Oxfordshire District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) No.1 Order 2005*
2. *In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the expressions specified in column 1 of Schedule 1 to this Order shall have the meanings respectively assigned to them in column 2 of that schedule.*
3. *The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.*

PART II

USE OF PARKING PLACE

4. *Each area of land specified by name and description in column (1) of Schedule 2 to this Order (“the Parking Place”) may be used subject to the following provisions of this Order as a parking place for such classes of Vehicles in such positions on such days and during such hours as are specified in the said Schedule 2.*
5. *Where within the Parking Place there is a sign or surface marking which indicates that a Parking Bay is available only for a Vehicle of a specified class or in a specified position the Driver of a Vehicle shall not permit it to wait in that Parking Bay unless it is of the class and in the position so specified.*
6. *Where within the Parking Place, there is a sign or surface marking which indicates that a Parking Bay is available only for a Disabled Person’s Vehicle the Driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in that Parking Bay unless the vehicle is either driven or occupied as a passenger by the holder of a Disabled Person’s Badge on display in that Vehicle.*
7. *Where within the Parking Place there is a sign or surface marking which indicates the maximum period during which a Vehicle may wait within a Parking Bay the Driver of a Vehicle shall not permit it to wait in that Parking Bay for longer than the maximum period so specified.*
8. *When a vehicle has left a Parking Bay within the Parking Place after waiting therein the Driver thereof shall not within one hour after leaving permit it to wait again anywhere upon the Parking Place.*

9. *The Driver of the Vehicle using the Parking Place shall stop the engine as soon as the Vehicle is in position in the Parking Place and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the Vehicle in or to depart from the Parking Place.*
10. *No person shall use a Vehicle while it is in the Parking Place in connection with the sale or offer for sale of any article to persons in or near the Parking Place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skill or services or for any form of advertisement.*
11. *No person shall use the Parking Place or any part thereof as a waiting or storage place for a Vehicle pending the sale of that Vehicle.*
12. *No person shall use any part of the Parking Place or any Vehicle left in the Parking Place:-*
 - (a) *for sleeping or camping or cooking purposes; or*
 - (b) *for the purpose of servicing repair maintenance or washing any Vehicle or part thereof other than is reasonably necessary to enable that Vehicle to depart from the Parking Place.*
13. *For the purpose of meeting the requirements of an emergency a person authorised in that behalf by the Council or a police constable in uniform may alter or cause to be altered the position of a Vehicle in the Parking Place or remove or arrange for the removal of a Vehicle from the Parking Place.*
14. *Any person altering or causing the alteration of the position of a Vehicle or removing or causing the removal of a Vehicle by virtue of Article 13 of this Order may do so by towing or driving the Vehicle or in such other manner as he may think reasonably necessary to enable the position of the Vehicle to be altered or the vehicle to be removed.*
15. *Any person removing or arranging for the removal of a Vehicle by virtue of Article 13 of this Order shall make such arrangements as he considers reasonably to be necessary for the safety of the Vehicle in the place to which it is removed.*
16. *The Driver of a Vehicle using the Parking Place shall not sound any horn or other similar instrument except when about to change the position of the Vehicle in or to depart from the Parking Place.*
17. *No person shall except with the written permission of any person authorised by the Council in that behalf drive or permit to be driven any Vehicle in the Parking Place for any purpose other than for the purpose of leaving that Vehicle in the Parking Place in accordance with the provisions of this Order or for the purpose of departing from the Parking Place.*
18. *No person shall use the Parking Place as a means of passage for proceeding from one road to another or from a road to any land adjoining the Parking Place.*
19. *Where in the Parking Place signs are erected or surface markings are laid for the purpose of:*
 - (a) *indicating the entrance to or exit from the Parking Place; or*
 - (b) *indicating that a Vehicle using the Parking Place shall proceed in a specified direction within the Parking Place,*

no person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any Vehicle

- (i) so that it enters the Parking Place otherwise than by an entrance so indicated; or,*
- (ii) leaves the Parking Place otherwise than by an exit so indicated; or*
- (iii) in a direction other than as specified as the case may be*

except by express prior written agreement with the Council for the purpose of gaining access to or from or of loading or unloading goods or passengers at any premises adjoining the Parking Place.

20. In the Parking Place no person shall:-

- (a) erect or cause or permit to be erected any tent booth stand building or other structure or advertisement either free standing or on a Vehicle without the written consent of the Council;*
- (b) light or cause or permit to be lit any fire;*
- (c) play or cause or permit to be played any radio cassette compact disc instrument or similar item in such manner as may be or become a nuisance to other users of the Parking Place or to the owners or occupiers of properties adjoining the Parking Place;*
- (d) use or permit to be used in the Parking Place a Vehicle in such a manner as to cause any excessive noise which could have been avoided by the exercise of reasonable care on the part of the driver of the Vehicle;*
- (e) play any games of any nature or wantonly shout or otherwise make any loud noise to the disturbance or annoyance of users of the Parking Place or occupiers of premises in the neighbourhood; or*
- (f) use any threatening abusive or insulting language gesture or conduct so as to occasion a breach of the peace or whereby a breach of the peace is likely to be occasioned.*

21. The Council may at any time close the Parking Place or any part or parts thereof temporarily.

22. The Council shall not be liable in respect of loss of or damage to any Vehicle or the fittings or contents of any Vehicle waiting or moving in or entering or leaving or otherwise using the Parking Place.

23. A notice may be attached to a Vehicle by a Car Park Officer for the purpose of bringing to the attention of the driver of the Vehicle any provision of this Order.

24. (a) Where a vehicle is left in the Parking Place in contravention of any of the provisions of Part II of this Order other than Article 6 (Disabled Person's Vehicle Parking Places) then a penalty charge of £70 shall be payable by the driver to the Council PROVIDED THAT if within fourteen days following the date when a Penalty Charge Notice is

issued as provided in Article 25 of this Order the Driver tenders the sum of £35 then such latter sum may be accepted by the Council in satisfaction of the penalty charge.

- (b) Where a vehicle is left in the Parking Place in contravention Article 6 of this Order (Disabled Person's Vehicle Parking Places) then a penalty charge of £70 shall be payable by the driver to the Council.

25. In the case of a Vehicle in respect of which payment of a penalty charge has been incurred the Car Park Officer will issue a Penalty Charge Notice by attaching to the Vehicle in a conspicuous position a notice giving the following particulars:-

- (i) the make, model and registration mark of (or the number of the trade licence plate carried by) the Vehicle;
- (ii) the date and time at which the Penalty Charge Notice was issued;
- (iii) the reason for issuing the Penalty Charge Notice;
- (iv) a statement that the Penalty Charge of £70 is required to be paid;
- (v) the manner in which and the time within which the Penalty Charge should be paid and in the case of all contraventions other than of Article 6 of this Order, or in which the lesser sum of £35 may be tendered as provided in Article 24 of this Order; and
- (vi) a statement that it is an offence under Section 35A of the 1984 Act for the driver of the vehicle to fail to pay the Penalty Charge

26. In the event of any contravention of or non-compliance with any of the provisions of this Order the person responsible shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding the maximum penalty prescribed by Section 33 of and Schedule 2 to the Road Traffic Offenders Act 1988 or any statutory modification or re-enactment of the same for the time being in force and the Council may institute proceedings against such person.

27. When a Penalty Charge Notice has been attached to a Vehicle pursuant to Articles 23, 24 and 25 of this Order no person other than a person authorised by the Council in that behalf or the driver of a Vehicle or a person authorised by the Driver of the Vehicle in that behalf shall remove the notice from the Vehicle.

28. The following Vehicles when left in the Parking Place shall be exempt from the provisions herein contained relating to the maximum period for parking in the Parking Place:-

- (a) an Invalid Carriage;
- (b) a Vehicle issued to a disabled person by the Department of Social Security in lieu of an Invalid Carriage; or
- (c) a Disabled Person's Vehicle;

PROVIDED THAT such exemption shall apply only if the following conditions are complied with:-

- (i) *the vehicle is left in a Parking Bay reserved for the Vehicles of Disabled Persons unless all such bays are already occupied in which case the Vehicle may be left in another Parking Bay; and*
 - (ii) *the Vehicle is either driven or occupied as a passenger by the holder of the Disabled Person's Badge; and*
 - (iii) *the Disabled Person's Badge is displayed in a Conspicuous Position on the Vehicle.*
29. *Vehicles in use for police, fire or ambulance purposes by the emergency services whilst dealing with an emergency shall be exempt from the provisions of this Order.*

PART III

REMOVAL OF VEHICLES

30. *When a vehicle is left in the Parking Place in contravention of Articles 5, 6 or 8 of this Order a person authorised in that behalf by the Council may remove the Vehicle or arrange for it to be removed from the Parking Place PROVIDED THAT when a Vehicle is waiting in the Parking Place in contravention of the provisions of Article 5 such person may alter or cause to be altered the position of the Vehicle in order that its position shall comply with that provision.*
31. *Any person removing or altering the position of a Vehicle by virtue of Article 30 of this Order may do so by towing or driving the Vehicle or taking such other measures as may reasonably be necessary to enable him to remove it or alter its position.*
32. *When a person authorised by the Council removes or makes arrangements for the removal of a Vehicle in accordance with Article 30 of this Order he shall make such arrangements as may reasonably be necessary for the safe custody of the Vehicle.*
33. *The following Order is hereby repealed:*
- The West Oxfordshire District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (No.2) Order 2004.*

SCHEDULE I

1. Expression	2. Meaning
<i>Car Park Officer</i>	<i>A person authorised by or on behalf of the Council to supervise the Parking Place.</i>
<i>Conspicuous Position</i>	<i>In the case of a Vehicle fitted with a front windscreen a position thereof with the obverse side facing forwards on the near side of an immediately behind the windscreen or in the case of a Vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, any other conspicuous position on the Vehicle.</i>
<i>Disabled Person</i>	<i>A disabled person of a description prescribed by Regulation 6 of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Amendment) Regulations 1991.</i>
<i>Disabled Person's Badge</i>	<i>A badge in the form prescribed by Regulation 5 of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Amendment) Regulations 1991 issued by a local authority for display on a motor vehicle driven by a disabled person or used for the carriage of a disabled person or several disabled persons.</i>
<i>Disabled Person's Vehicle</i>	<i>A Vehicle lawfully displaying a Disabled Person's Badge.</i>
<i>Driver</i>	<i>The person driving a vehicle at the time when it is left in the Parking Place.</i>
<i>Invalid Carriage</i>	<i>A mechanically propelled Vehicle of which the weight unladen does not exceed 254 kilogrammes and which is specially designed and constructed and not merely adapted for the use of a person suffering from some physical default or disability and is used solely by such a person or a vehicle issued to a Disabled Person by the Department of Social Security in lieu of an Invalid Carriage.</i>
<i>24 Hour Period</i>	<i>The continuous 24 Hour period commencing at 08.00 hrs.</i>

Motor Car	(a) if it is constructed solely for the carriage of passengers and their effects is adapted to carry a load of not more than seven passengers exclusive of the driver and is fitted with tyres of such type as may be specified in Regulations made by the Secretary of State does not exceed 3050 kilogram's;
	(b) if it is constructed or adapted for use for the conveyance of goods or burden of any description does not exceed 3050 kilogram's or 3500 kilogram's if the Vehicle carries a container or containers for holding for the purposes of its propulsion any fuel which is wholly gaseous at 17.5 degrees Celsius under a pressure of 1.013 bar or plant and materials for producing such fuel; or
	(c) in a case falling within neither of the foregoing paragraphs does not exceed 2540 kilogram's.
Motor Cycle	A mechanically propelled vehicle (not being an invalid carriage) with fewer than 4 wheels of which the weight unladen must not exceed 410 kilogram's.
Vehicle	A mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on roads.
Parking Bay	Each area of the Parking Place which is provided for the parking of a motor vehicle and which is so indicated by markings on the surface of the parking place.
Parking Place	Each area of land the situation of which is described in Column 1 of Schedule 2 to this Order.
Trailer	A non-mechanically propelled vehicle drawn by a Vehicle.
